
Minnesota Junior All-Breeds Convention Long Range Production Award

REQUIREMENTS:

- The animal entered for the award must have been a Junior Breed Association member's project (may include managerial projects). Please include documentation of managerial projects, i.e. copy of one of the following: 4-H record, FFA record, Jr. Breed Association Record Book.
- Only production records made during the actual time that the animal was a Junior Breed Association member's project may be credited toward the lifetime production of the cow, which is under consideration for the award.
- One award will be given in each production class per animal. If the animal is still in the same production class the following year, no award will be given.
- An animal must have reached 50,000 lbs. of milk to be entered. Recognition is given for 50,000 lbs., 100,000 lbs., and 200,000 lbs., of lifetime milk. Awards to be designated by the Jr. Holstein Programs Committee.
- Types of sampling approved are supervised DHI. Testing deadline is Dec. 31st, 2021.
- The awards will be given to registered and grade animals.
- All entries must be submitted to the MHA Office by the deadline of **February 15th, 2022**.
- All records will be subject to approval and verification by the Jr. Advisory Committee.
- Applicants must be current MJHA members.
- Please enclose a copy of both sides of individual cow page.
- Duplicate forms as need to enter additional animals.
